**SIXTH FORM HISTORY TRIP**  
**Tower of London**  
**Monday 9 December 2024**

A Sixth Form History trip to the Tower of London has been arranged for **Monday 9 December 2024**. During the day, students will analyse the Tower's role in the Wars of the Roses and in cementing the reigns of both Yorkist and Lancastrian kings, through its functions as royal palace, makeshift prison and execution site.

The cost of visiting the Tower of London and attending the education session is £11.00 which will be payable via ParentPay. **However, there will be a transport cost of £20 for the bus to London plus students will need to bring a contactless payment card to pay for travel on the underground (no more than £8).** Please be advised that if your child does not bring the money for transport, they will not be able to travel.

We will be meeting at Gloucester Green, Oxford at 6.30am and will be back in Oxford by about 5.30pm.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch or money to buy food.
