I am pleased to announce that on Saturday 1st February 2025, Cambrian Learning Trust and Vale Academy Trust officially merged.

Cambrian Learning Trust (formerly Faringdon Learning Trust) and The Vale Academy Trust have now merged, creating a Trust consisting of four secondary schools and 15 primary schools in the South Oxfordshire area. A number of 'Alliance Schools' have also been working with Cambrian Learning Trust for some time.

The schools that make up the new Cambrian Learning Trust are:
