I would like to offer your child the opportunity to attend the Year 11 Poetry Live event at the New Theatre, Oxford on Monday 10 February 2025. The visit will comprise a one-day conference at the Forum on the students' GCSE Literature poetry unit.

Places are limited and if we receive more applicants than places, names will be selected randomly, and a reserve list will be created.

This conference provides students with the opportunity to hear, directly from the examiners, how best to approach the paper. In addition, some poets from the Power and Conflict sections of the poetry anthology will recite their poems to the audience and explain them in detail. As well as being an outstanding cultural experience, this will provide students with invaluable insight into the skills needed for this section of their English Literature exam. Travelling by coach, students will leave FCC at 9am. They will need to be collected from school at around 4.30pm. Students are expected to wear full uniform and bring a nut-free packed lunch.
