The Duke of Edinburgh's Gold Award 2024 - 2025

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am pleased to be able to offer FCC Sixth Form students the opportunity to participate in The Gold Duke of Edinburgh Award.

At Gold level, students are required to complete 5 sections: volunteering, physical, skill, expedition and a residential activity. More information about the different sections can be found here: https://www.dofe.org/do/sections/ If the Silver Award or Silver Certificate of Achievement has not been completed, then students are required to complete an extra 6 months in either the Volunteering or the longer of the Physical or Skills section.

Participants will need to find and book their own expeditions. This allows students to select expeditions that fit around their studies and exams. It also opens up other ways of completing the expedition such as canoeing, cycling and horse riding. Participants can use the opportunity finder on the DofE website to search for approved expedition companies (https://www.dofe.org/opportunity-finder/opportunity-for-dofe-participant/?paged=1).

If your child would like to participate in the Gold Award this academic year, please complete the participant enrolment form which can be found here: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSfh5-ecbErDLsLgNYD8jiQSe6jCN3EIQXZxCu3joBuFkEy-NQ/viewform?usp=sf_link by **14th October**. Please ensure that your browser is logged into your child's school account to access the form.

The cost of £36 only includes registration with the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Expedition and residential costs vary according to the type and location but are likely to be around £400 for walking expeditions and higher for other expedition activities, such as canoeing. There are some free residential activities such as University taster weeks, however costs for residents vary considerably from around £300 upwards. As there is a considerable cost implication, participants have until they are 25 to complete the award, with many focusing on completing the 4 sections and the expedition during Sixth Form and taking part in a residential activity later.

Payment needs to made before your child's place is confirmed on the Award
