Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to meet so many of you at the Used Uniform Sale on Monday. The event was a great success, and we will be holding another sale in June on a date to be confirmed.

The school website now has a copy of the uniform information that has been sent to you but also contains helpful links to our supplier PMG School Wear including price lists and size information.

Following the sale on Monday and some queries regarding mandatory items and branded school wear, I have included the list below to clarify what is required.

### **Main Uniform**

**White shirt** – This is a mandatory item, which must be worn throughout the year.

**FCC Tie** – This is a mandatory item, which must be worn throughout the year.

**Navy Blazer bearing the FCC crest** – This is a mandatory item. However, if there are concerns regarding the purchase of this item, we do have some second-hand blazers available or would be happy to discuss practical solutions.

**Navy tailored trousers or navy knee-length pleated skirt** – This is a mandatory item, which must be worn throughout the year. This item does not have to be branded and can be purchased from a range of retailers.

**Navy V-neck jumper bearing the FCC crest** – It is advised that this item is branded. However, if it is more financially viable for parents/carers, then an unbranded navy-blue V-neck school jumper can be worn and can be purchased from a range of retailers and can also be purchased second hand, if sourced by the parent/carer. This item does not have to be worn throughout the year but can be selected at the student's discretion. It is important to note that the jumper is not a substitute for the blazer. The FCC crest should be purchased separately and affixed securely.

**Plain black footwear** (trainers are allowed, but the soles must be black) – This is a mandatory item, which must be worn throughout the year. This item does not have to be branded and can be purchased from a range of retailers.

**School bag** – This is a mandatory item, which must be brought into school throughout the year. Rucksack or similar are recommended. A drawstring sports bag is recommended for PE kit. It is forbidden for students to carry bags with offensive materials/messaging on them.

**Pencil Case** – Students will need a pencil case with maths equipment, pens, ruler, rubber and coloured pencils or pens. A scientific calculator will also be needed, and the Maths team will forward suggestions for these soon.

**Summer uniform** – During Terms 5 and 6 only, students may choose to wear navy blue tailored shorts with a short-sleeved white shirt. Students will still be expected to wear their tie and blazer.

Banned items – please note this is not an exhaustive list.

No jewellery (A stud in each lobe is permitted)

No hoodies

No leggings

### **PE Uniform**

The FCC PE T Shirt and FCC PE Jumper/Rugby Top or Quarter Zip is mandatory.

Students should also have navy shorts, tracksuit bottoms, or sports leggings of their choosing - they can be FCC branded OR plain black/blue. No large logos or bright colours.

Running shoes are mandatory. Students should not be wearing their school shoes for PE.

Football boots for Rugby and Football lessons are recommended. A change of socks for PE is essential; these do not have to be FCC but must be navy.

If you have any queries regarding uniform, please let us know. We recognise this will be the mostly costly expense for September and will work hard to resolve any concerns.
