


Your Childs HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) Vaccination is due – Year 8

	Unsure if your child has already had this vaccination? This vaccine is usually given from school Year 8 in the UK. If you think your child may have already received it, check your vaccine records/ask your GP surgery before submitting your form.
	If your child missed both school sessions or does not attend school you can arrange a community clinic appointment via our website. https://oxfordhealth.nhs.uk/imms/parents/ Please email us if you need any assistance.
Are your Childs other vaccines up to date?	Check to ensure your child has received all the vaccinations they are eligible for including two doses of MMR.
