## The Duke of Edinburgh's Bronze Award 2025-26

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am excited to be able to offer your child the opportunity to participate in The Bronze Duke of Edinburgh (DofE) Award. To complete the award, participants are required to complete 4 sections, including volunteering, physical, skill and expedition. There will be an online parents information session held via google meet on Wednesday 16 July at 6pm where I will explain the enrolment process, the DofE programme and I will be happy to answer your questions. A deposit of £100 to secure your child's place on the Award must be paid by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> October.

• All costs associated with the DofE Approved Activity provider delivering the Expedition (e.g. instructors, assessors, camp fees, insurance, tents, stoves, gas, maps)

#### The cost **does not** include:

- Food whilst on expeditions
- Kit costs (other than those mentioned above) e.g. rucksack, sleeping bag, sleeping mat, walking boots (a full kit list will be provided)
- Travel to and from the practice and assessed expeditions (The location is to be confirmed, however, it will be the local area and should be no more than 30 minutes away by car from FCC).

The practice and assessed expeditions will be run by a Duke of Edinburgh Approved Activity Provider; BXM Expeditions. More information about the company can be found on their website <a href="https://www.bxmoutdoors.com/">https://www.bxmoutdoors.com/</a>

The contact details you submit on the enrolment form will be shared with BXM, so that they can contact you regarding your child's medical requirements for the duration of the expeditions.

Students will only be allowed to take part in the practice expedition (and the assessed expedition) if they have attended the training day which will be delivered as part of a personal development day in school during term 3.
