I am excited to be able to offer your child the opportunity to participate in The Silver Duke of Edinburgh (DofE) Award. To complete the award, participants are required to complete 4 sections, including volunteering, physical, skill and expedition. If your child would like to take part, please complete the participant enrolment form, which can be found here <https://forms.gle/dJgaL5zQswwfKwvt6> by **Sunday 21 September**. Please ensure that your browser is logged into your child's school account to access the form.

The total cost of the Award is £310. A deposit of £110 to secure your child's place on the Award must be paid by 1 October.

Practice Expedition, 3 full days including two overnight camps.	Friday 1 May – Sunday 3 May 2026
Assessed Expeditions, 3 full days including two overnight camps.	Saturday 11 July – Monday 13 July 2026

Students will only be allowed to take part in the practice expedition (and the assessed expedition) if they have attended the training day on **Tuesday 10 February**.
