You Said	We Have
Newsletters and comms were described as generic and impersonal, with little actionable information	We have reviewed the content shared in our Weekly Digest to ensure we provide clear, relevant and useful information for all parents. We have also reviewed the end-of-term newsletter to ensure it reflects all aspects of the school, not just the Sixth Form.
Concerns were raised about the cleanliness of the school buildings	We have moved to a new cleaning contractor through a revised service level agreement. Since making this change, we have seen a significant improvement in cleanliness across the school site.
Concerns raised around poor conditions of toilets	We have refurbished two sets of toilets in the main block. Additional refurbishment of further toilet blocks is planned for the summer holiday.
The school is not consistent with its approach to uniform	We have introduced an option for students to wear navy blue tailored shorts during Terms 5 and 6. We have also been actively reminding students to remove white socks, as they are not part of the school uniform, and to ensure their shirts are tucked in. In addition, we have communicated that from Terms 5 and 6 onwards, students will not be permitted to wear hoodies in school.
