Course Content:

Unit 1 – The War of the Roses 1445–1499

Students will be able to explore the War of the Roses and the various factional disputes in England before the coming of the Tudors – sex, death and toilets!

Unit 2 – Russia 1855-1964

This unit provides an opportunity to study Russian history over 100 years, drawing links between how the country has been run under the tsars and then the communists.

Unit 3 at A2 Level – students will be required to complete a piece of coursework on any topic from any country of their choice.

Teacher led, discussion and debate, group work, independent reading and research, note taking. There will be 2 examinations at AS Level which will be essay-based and 2 similar examinations at A2.
