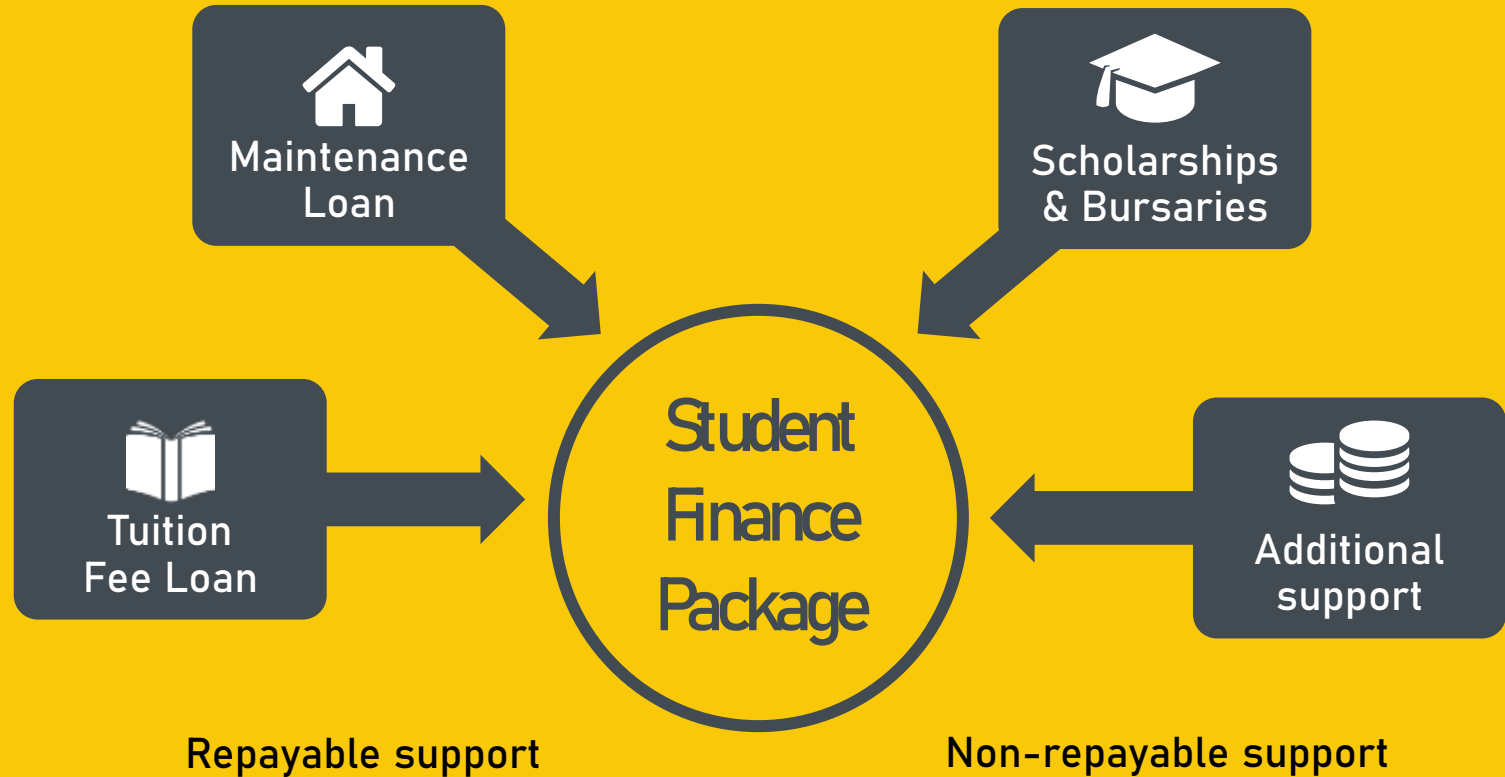


How much does university tuition

Tuition Fee Loan

- Available to all
- Not dependent on household income
- Paid directly to the university

Maintenance Loan

- Covers living costs
- Amount depends on where you live and your household income
- Paid into your bank account in three instalments

When do I repay my loan?

The April after you
finish your course

AND

When your income is
over £25,000

How much do I have to repay?

Tuition & Maintenance loans are combined
Only pay 9% of your income OVER £25,000

Income before tax	9% is deducted from	Yearly Repayment	Monthly Repayment
£25,000	£0	£0	£0
£30,000	£5,000	£450	£37
£35,000	£10,000	£900	£75

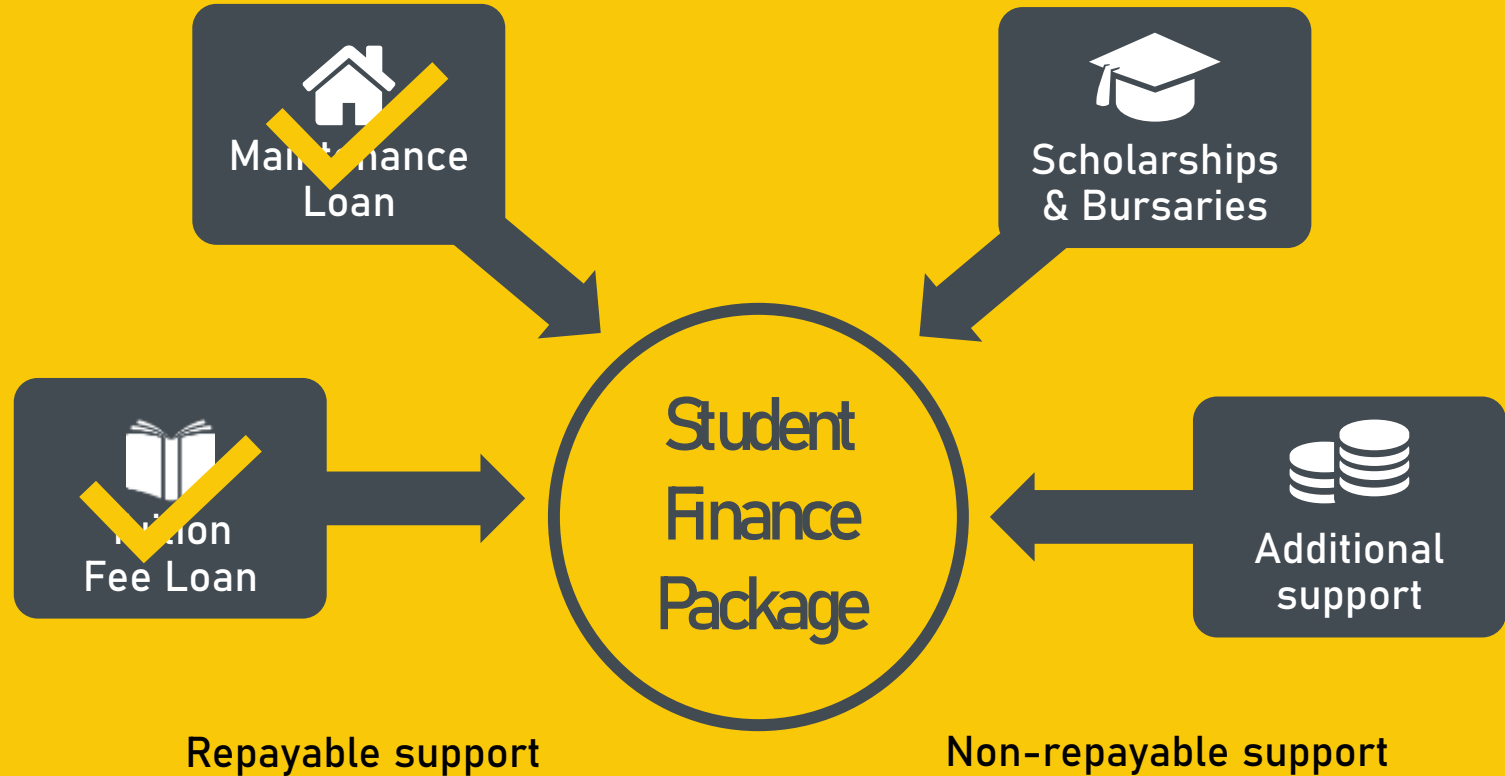

What else should I know?

- Your loan will gain 7.6% interest
- Everything is written off 40 years after graduation
- It's calculated by HMRC & your employer
- It doesn't matter how much money you borrow, you'll repay the same amount per month



How will you pay for it?





NHS Training Grant

- Minimum of £5,000 per year
- For healthcare courses like Nursing, Midwifery, Paramedic Science, Physiotherapy, and Occupational Therapy
- In addition to existing loan

DSA

Students can get up to £25,575 a year for support including:

- specialist equipment
- non-medical helpers
- extra travel
- other disability-related study support





Scholarships


- Subject or sport specific (results or achievement)
- Geographic (company giving back to local community)
- Linked to personal circumstances (socio-economic, underrepresented groups)
- Have limited availability



Bursaries

- Linked to personal circumstances and household income
- Take the form of discounted accommodation, tuition fees, or financial aid
- Share your circumstances with the university so they can support you
- All universities use different criteria

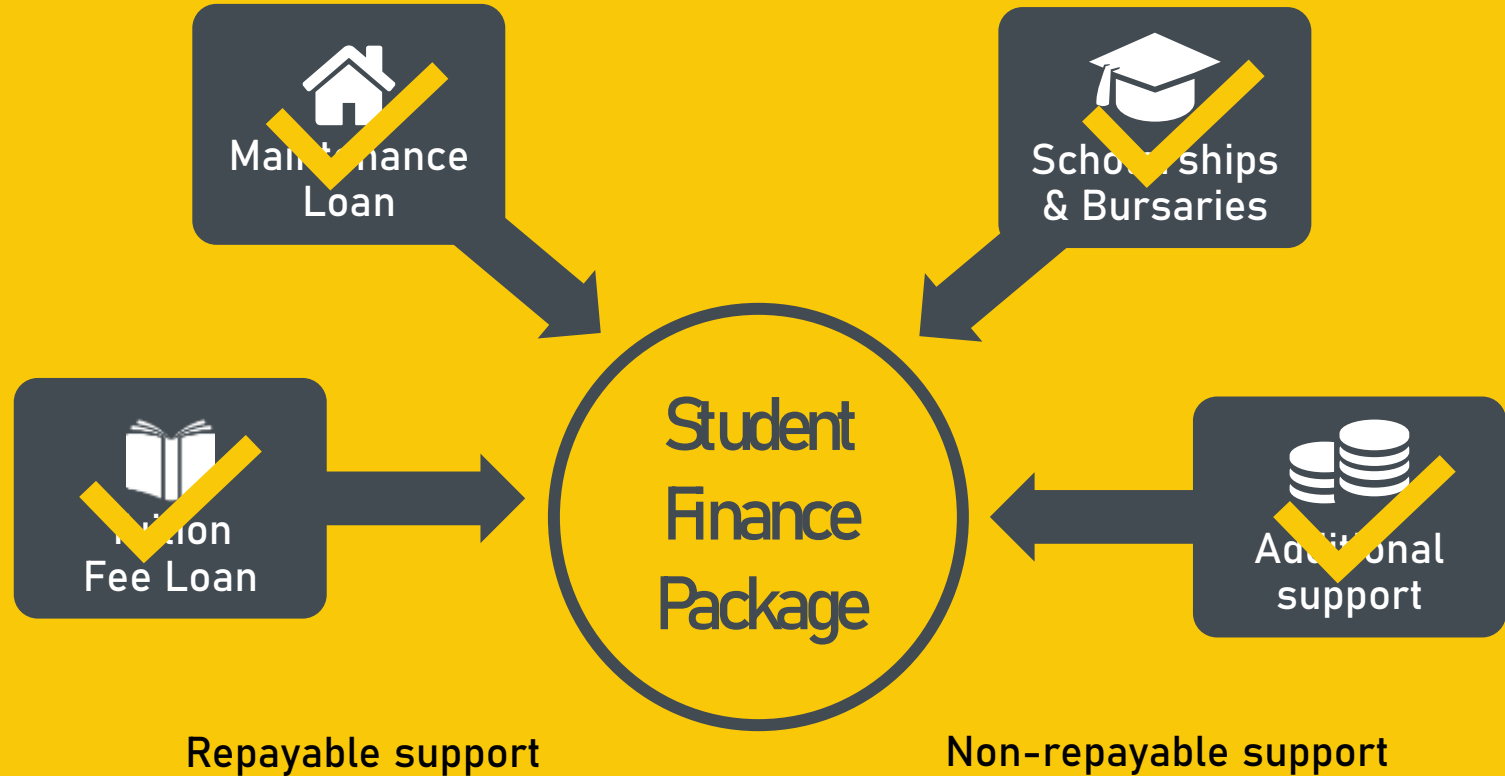
